Mineral Extractor for Chambered Vortech Tank

The Mineral Extractor !s designed for use on chambered tanks with a fixed riser tube. The offset center shaft will slide along the side of the stationary tube.

Included is a "Cap Removal Tool", which is used to remove the plugs that separate the different chambers from each other. Also included is a lower chamber extension for the removal of media from the lower chambers, if necessary.


NOTE: The "Cap Removal Tool" can also be used as a refill tube, by removing the handle and using a funnel inside the tube to wash in the new media.

Directions for Use

For One or First Chamber Removal:

- 1. Remove head assembly from the vessel.
- 2. Screw black adapter with offset center shaft onto tank and push to bottom of chamber.
- 3. Attach water/garden hose and remove media from chamber.

For Second Chamber Removal:



- 1. Remove extractor assembly from vessel.
- 2. Using the cap removal tool, slide tool down over riser/distributor tube to the cap at the bottom of the top chamber.
- 3. Align notches (as shown to the right) and push down counter clockwise to release the cap, then slide up the riser tube.
- 4. Repeat Step 2 (above) after adding lower extension tube.



CAUTION: Turn Water on Slowly to Remove Media, too Fast Will Clog the Extractor!
